AURORA MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO SEX ACT WITH MINOR

March 7, 2012

An Aurora man has pleaded guilty to having sexual contact with a minor girl he knew.

Robert D. Lammers, 38 (d.o.b. 2-8-1974), of the 600 block of South Gladstone Avenue, Aurora, today agreed with the Kane County State's Attorney to a sentence of 4½ years in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to one count of aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony.

Associate Judge Allen M. Anderson accepted the plea.

On Nov. 8, 2010, Lammers had sexual contact with a minor girl he knew. The girl was younger than 13 years old at the time.

In addition to the prison term, Lammers must register for life as a sex offender in accordance with the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act. In addition, he must avoid contact with the victim.

Lammers is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He was given credit for 45 days served in the Kane County jail.

The case was investigated by the Aurora Police Department and the Kane County Child Advocacy Center. The case was prosecuted by Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Debra Bree.
