TYRELL SUMLING OF ELGIN PLEADS GUILTY TO HOME INVASION, GETS 13½ YEARS IN PRISON

August 1, 2019

An Elgin man will go to prison for threatening a man with a dangerous weapon in the man's home in 2018.

32-year-old **Tyrell D. Sumling** on July 31, 2019, agreed to a sentence of 13½ years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of home invasion, Class X felony.

Kane County Circuit Judge John A. Barsanti accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Samantha Cain stated in court that on May 29, 2018, Sumling, while armed with a dangerous weapon, remained in the victim's home in the 1-99 block of North Edison Avenue, Elgin, threatened to use force against the victim.

In accordance with Illinois law, Sumling is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He receives credit for 426 days served in the Kane County jail, where he has been held since his arrest in lieu of \$750,000 bail. Bond was revoked upon conviction.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Mark D. Stajdohar prosecuted the case.
