SIXTH OFFENDER GUILTY IN 2016 ELGIN KIDNAPPING

MEGAN LINO GETS 12-YEAR PRISON SENTENCE

February 22, 2019

A sixth offender is now convicted in a 2016 kidnapping scheme in Elgin.

Associate Judge Kathryn D. Karayannis today sentenced 22-year-old Megan A. Lino of Carpentersville to 12 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Lino on Feb. 8, 2019, pleaded guilty to the offense of:

Home invasion, Class X felony.

On Feb. 26, 2016, Lino, and co-defendants Luis Palomar, Kassandra Delgado and Ruby Gomez kidnapped the victim from an Elgin residence, beat her, brought her to Gino Moraca's Elgin apartment, and continued to beat her, burn her with lit cigarettes and hold her against her will.

Palomar, Delgado, Gomez, and Moraca pleaded guilty in the case in 2018 and were sentenced to prison.

In addition, a sixth offender previously pleaded guilty in the case in juyenile court. Illinois law prohibits authorities from disclosing more specific information about juvenile offenders and their cases.

According to Illinois law, Lino is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. She receives credit for 232 days served in the Kane County jail.

The case was prosecuted by Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Kelly M. Orland and Daniel Weiler.
