CARPENTERSVILLE MAN FACES PRISON SENTENCE FOR 2005 SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A CHILD

June 13, 2019

A Carpentersville man is waiting to learn his prison sentence after he was convicted for sexually assaulting a child he knew.

Kane County Circuit Judge Donald M. Tegeler, Jr., on Wednesday, June 12, 2019, convicted 37-year-old **Jesus Bermudez** of the offense of:

- Predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony

Bermudez waived his right to a jury trial.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Matthew Rodgers and Debra Bree presented evidence that around 2005 Bermudez sexually assaulted the victim, who was younger than 13 years old at the time. Bermudez knew the victim.

Judge Tegeler set Bermudez's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. August 15, 2019, for motions and sentencing. Bermudez faces a sentence of between 6 and 30 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Bermudez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

The Kane County Child Advocacy Center investigated the case.
