### **AURORA MAN GETS 15 YEARS FOR CHILD SEX ASSAULTS**

April 14, 2020

38-year-old **Jose L. Baca** on March 19, 2020, agreed to a sentence of 15 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offenses of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony, and aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony.

Kane County Associate Judge Charles E. Petersen accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Matthew Rodgers stated in court that between March 2011 and March 2018, Baca sexually assaulted and sexually abused two victims. Baca knew the victims, who both were younger than 13 years old when the crimes began.

In addition to the prison term, Baca must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with Illinois' Sexual Offender Registration Act.

The sentence is 8 years for the Class X felony and 7 years for the Class 2 felony to be served consecutive to one another.

In accordance with Illinois law, Baca must serve at least 85 percent of the 8-year sentence and is eligible for day-for-day sentencing on the 7-year sentence. Baca receives credit for 723 days served in the Kane County jail.
