CAROL STREAM MAN CHARGED WITH STALKING FOR ALLEGEDLY PLACING TRACKING DEVICE ON ACQUAINTANCE'S VEHICLE

February 27, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 47-year-old **David D. Sampson** with the offense of stalking, Class 4 felony.

Kane County prosecutors allege that on Jan. 7, 2020, the victim discovered that Sampson, whom she knew, had placed a GPS tracking device on her car for a third time. The victim called St. Charles police when she discovered the device.

Sampson is free on \$1,000 bond. As a condition of bond he is prohibited from having contact with the victim, and he must stay away from the victim's home.

Sampson's next court appearance is set for 1:30 p.m. March 19, 2020, in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The St. Charles Police Department conducted the investigation.

The charges against Sampson are not proof of guilt. Sampson is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
