KANE JAIL INMATE CHARGED FOR POSSESSING SHANK

July 13, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 36-year-old **Michael A. Villagran** with the offenses of possessing a weapon in a penal institution, Class 1 felony, and unlawful use of a weapon, Class A misdemeanor.

Kane County prosecutors allege that on July 1, 2020, Villagran, a detainee at the Kane County jail, possessed a 6- to 7-inch metal shank with a sharpened point.

Villagran appeared July 9, 2020, in Kane County bond court. Kane County Judge Michael Noland set Villagran's bail at \$200,000, with 10 percent (\$20,000) to apply for bond.

Judge Noland set Villagran's next court appearance for 9 a.m. July 15, 2020, in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Villagran are not proof of guilt. Villagran is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
