**PAIR CHARGED FOR ALLEGEDLY COMMITTING GUN OFFENSES  
WHILE FREE ON BOND**

**ONE DEFENDANT PREVIOUSLY CHARGED WITH ARMED ROBBERY,  
OTHER PREVIOUSLY CHARGED WITH AGGRAVATED ASSAULT**

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 19-year-old **Rayquan L. Smith** with the offenses of:

- Armed violence, Class X felony
- Possession of a firearm with a defaced serial number, Class 3 felony
- Aggravated unlawful use of a weapon, Class 4 felony, 2 counts
- Violation of bail bond by possessing a firearm, Class 4 felony
- Unlawful possession of a controlled substance, Class 4 felony
- Obstructing identification, Class A misdemeanor
- Driving with an expired license, Class B misdemeanor

and

23-year-old **Jeremiah D. Delt** with the offenses of:

- Aggravated unlawful use of a weapon, Class 4 felony, 2 counts
- Violation of bail bond by possessing a firearm, Class 4 felony
- Resisting a police officer, Class A misdemeanor

Kane County prosecutors allege that at about 3:30 a.m. June 18, 2020, Elgin police conducted a traffic stop at DuPage Street and Park Row. While searching Smith, police found a loaded 9mm handgun with the serial number removed and unprescribed Xanax pills on him, and they found a loaded semiautomatic rifle in the car under the front passenger seat.

At the time Smith was free on \$15,000 bond for a May 2020 Kane County charge of armed robbery, Class X felony (Case No. 20CF818), and Delt was free on \$150 bond for a June 15, 2020, Kane County charge of aggravated assault, Class A misdemeanor (Case No. 20CM1479.)

Smith remains in custody in the Kane County jail on a total of \$550,000 bail with 10 percent (\$55,000) to apply for bond. His next court date is set for 9 a.m. July 13, 2020, in Courtroom 305 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

Delt remains in custody in the Kane County jail on a total of \$200,000 bail with 10 percent (\$20,000) to apply for bond. His next court date is at 9 a.m. June 29, 2020, in Courtroom 305 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Smith and Delt are not proof of guilt. Smith and Delt are presumed innocent and are entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove their guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.

**Rayquan L. Smith:** Age 19 (d.o.b. 5-20-2001), of the 1100 block of Apple Lane, Elgin, Illinois, and also of Chicago. Case No. 20CF1094.

**Jeremiah D. Delt:** Age 23 (d.o.b. 10-22-1996), of the 2900 block of South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois. Case No. 20CF1093.
