AURORA WOMAN DRIVING WITH CHILD IN CAR FACES DUI CHARGES PROSECUTORS, POLICE ALLEGE DRIVER STRUCK PARKED VEHICLE

March 30, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 33-year-old **Alma G. Manzo** with the offense of aggravated DUI, Class 4 felony, 4 counts.

Kane County prosecutors allege that just before midnight March 28, 2020, the Nissan Pathfinder Manzo was driving struck a parked vehicle near the intersection of Claim and Union streets in Aurora. When stopped by police, Manzo displayed multiple signs of intoxication. In addition a young child was in the Manzo's car at the time, Manzo's license was suspended and she had no insurance.

Manzo appeared March 29, 2020, in Kane County bond court. A Kane County judge set Manzo's bail at \$25,000, and released her from custody on her promise to appear in court. As conditions of bond Manzo is prohibited from driving and from consuming alcohol.

The judge set Manzo's next court appearance for 9 a.m. May 20, 2020, in Courtroom 313 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Manzo are not proof of guilt. Manzo is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
