AURORA WOMAN CHARGED WITH DUI AFTER CRASH TWO CHILDREN RIDING IN ALLEGED OFFENDER'S CAR

March 31, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 21-year-old **Alexis Mata** with the offenses of:

- Aggravated DUI, Class 4 felony, 4 counts
- Child endangerment, Class A misdemeanor
- Driving while license suspended, Class A misdemeanor

Kane County prosecutors allege that at about 10:30 p.m. March 29, 2020, Mata was driving as vehicle that struck another vehicle in the 600 block of Hankes Avenue, Aurora. When interviewed by Aurora police, Mata allegedly showed signs of alcoholic impairment.

Mata's driver's license was suspended and her vehicle was not insured. Two children were riding in the car with her.

Mata appeared today in Kane County bond court. A Kane County judge set Mata's bail at \$15,000, and released her from custody on her promise to appear in court.

The judge set Mata's next court appearance for 9 a.m. May 21, 2020, in Courtroom 217 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Mata are not proof of guilt. Mata is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
