\$3 MILLION BAIL IN AURORA TOWNSHIP STABBING MURDER

November 3, 2020

Bail has been set at \$3 million for an Aurora Township man accused of stabbing to death 51-year-old Mario A. Ying of Aurora on Friday evening.

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon charged 40-year-old **Carlos Fonseca-Gutierrez** with the offenses of:

- First-degree murder, 2 counts
- Armed robbery, Class X felony

Kane County prosecutors allege that the evening of Oct. 30, 2020, Fonseca-Gutierrez walked from his home in the 1700 block of Indian Avenue, Aurora Township, to a residence in the 1500 block of Solfisburg Avenue, Aurora Township, where Ying was doing renovation/repair work. Both properties are owned by the same landlord. Fonseca-Gutierrez stabbed Ying multiple times, killing him.

Fonseca-Gutierrez appeared today in Kane County bond court. After determining bail – bond is \$300,000 – the judge set Fonseca-Gutierrez's next court appearance for 9 a.m. Nov. 5, 2020, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

If convicted of the most serious offense, Fonseca-Gutierrez faces a sentence of between 20 and 60 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

The Kane County Sheriff's Office conducted the investigation with assistance from the Kane County Major Crimes Task Force.

The charges against Fonseca-Gutierrez are not proof of guilt. Fonseca-Gutierrez is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
