AURORA MAN FACES PRISON SENTENCE FOR SEXUALLY ASSAULTING CHILD

October 5, 2020

A Kane County jury has convicted **Jammal J. Drane** of the offense of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Matthew Rodgers and Lori Anderson presented evidence that between January and October 2017 Drane sexually assaulted a child younger than 13 years old. Drane knew the child.

Drane's next court appearance is set for 1:30 p.m. January 8, 2021, in Courtroom 217 at the Kane County Judicial Center. Drane faces a sentence of between 6 and 60 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Drane must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Drane remains in custody at the Kane County jail, where he had been held since his arrest in lieu of \$800,000 bail. The judge revoked his bond upon conviction.

The Kane County Child Advocacy Center conducted the investigation.
