### **BAIL SET AT \$500,000 FOR ST. CHARLES MAN ACCUSED IN CRASH THAT KILLED 88-YEAR-OLD CHICAGO WOMAN IN WHEELCHAIR**

**HELEN RADNOTTI WAS BEING PUSHED THROUGH DOWNTOWN ST. CHARLES CROSSWALK  
WHEN STRUCK AND KILLED; PICKUP DRIVER ALLEGEDLY FLED WITHOUT ASSISTING VICTIM**

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 23-year-old **Andrew J. Jensen** with the offenses of:

- Failure to report an accident or death, Class 1 felony
- Leaving the scene of an accident involving personal injury or death, Class 4 felony
- Failure to yield at a crosswalk, Petty offense

Kane County prosecutors allege that the afternoon of Oct. 9, 2020, Jensen, driving a 2017 Dodge Ram 2500 pickup, failed to stop at the intersection of North Third and West Main streets, St. Charles, striking 88-year-old Helen Radnoti of Chicago, killing her. Radnoti was in a wheelchair. A man who was pushing her wheelchair sustained minor injuries. Jensen fled the scene without attempting to provide aid to the victim and failed to report the crash to police.

Jensen appeared today in Kane County bond court. The judge set Jensen's bail at \$500,000, with 10 percent (\$50,000) to apply for bond. If Jensen posts bond, he is prohibited from driving a motor vehicle. Jensen remains in custody at the Kane County jail.

Jensen's next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Oct. 20, 2020, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Jensen are not proof of guilt. Jensen is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
