WEST DUNDEE MAN SOUGHT ON WARRANT AFTER HIT-AND-RUN CRASH IN ELGIN

October 19, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 21-year-old **Bryan Aguirre** with the offense of leaving the scene of an accident involving personal injury, Class 4 felony.

Kane County prosecutors allege that at about 4:40 p.m. October 2, 2020, Aguirre, driving a Chevrolet SUV, struck the victim's vehicle from behind in the vicinity of South McLean Boulevard and Spartan Drive, causing a chain-reaction crash. The driver of the vehicle that Aguirre struck was taken to a hospital with minor injuries. Aguirre immediately fled in his vehicle, and a witness pursued him, noting details about the vehicle including the license plate.

A Kane County judge signed a warrant for Aguirre's arrest and set his bail at \$15,000, with 10 percent (\$1,500) to apply for bond. Aguirre's initial court appearance is to be determined.

The charges against Aguirre are not proof of guilt. Aguirre is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
