ST. CHARLES MAN FACES CHARGES FOR ALLEGED SEXUAL ASSAULT OF MINOR

September 16, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 26-year-old **Eduardo Castillo Vivaldo** with the offenses of:

- Criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony, 2 counts
- Aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony, 4 counts

Kane County prosecutors allege that Castillo Vivaldo initially contacted the victim via social media and, despite being told multiple times that the victim is a minor, continued to contact the victim via social media. On Aug. 20, 2020, Castillo Vivaldo drove to the victim's home in northwestern Kane County and, using force and despite the victim's pleas to stop, sexually assaulted the victim.

Kane County Circuit Judge Michael Noland signed a warrant for Castillo Vivaldo's arrest and set his bail at \$100,000, with 10 percent (\$10,000) to apply for bond.

Castillo Vivaldo surrendered Sept. 14, 2020, to police. He appeared Sept. 15 in Kane County bond court. Judge Noland set Castillo Vivaldo's next court appearance for 9 a.m. Sept. 18, 2020, in Courtroom 217 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The case remains under investigation. Anyone with information about Castillo Vivaldo should call the Kane County Child Advocacy Center at (630) 208-5160.

The charges against Castillo Vivaldo are not proof of guilt. Castillo Vivaldo is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
