TWO MEN CHARGED FOR ALLEGEDLY DEALING METH IN ELGIN

September 17, 2020

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 31-year-old **Jose Solorzano-Martinez** with the offenses of:

- Possession of methamphetamine with intent to deliver, Class 1 felony
- Possession of methamphetamine, Class 2 felony
- Resisting a police officer, Class A felony
- Unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia, Class A misdemeanor, 3 counts

And

Kane County State's Attorney Joe McMahon has charged 25-year-old **Julio Archundia-Sanchez** with the offenses of:

- Possession of methamphetamine, Class 3 felony
- Possession of a fraudulent ID card, Class 4 felony
- No valid driver's license, Class B misdemeanor

Kane County prosecutors allege that the evening of Sept. 14, 2020, an Elgin police officer saw a green Ford minivan driven by Achundia-Sanchez pull over to the west side of Mulberry Court near Mulberry Lane. The officer then saw the front passenger, Solorzano-Martinez, appear to engage in drug activity through the front passenger window. The minivan then pulled away, and the police vehicle followed and stopped the minivan after a driving infraction. During a search the officer found crystal methamphetamine, glass smoking pipes, items commonly associated with drug dealing and a fake Social Security card. The officer then placed both men under arrest.

Achundia-Sanchez and Solorzano-Martinez appeared Sept. 16, 2020, in Kane County bond court. Kane County Circuit Judge Michael Noland set the bond for each at \$100,000 with 10 percent (\$10,000) to apply for bond.

Judge Noland set the next court appearance for each for 9 a.m. Sept. 21, 2020, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Solorzano-Martinez and Archundia-Sanchez are not proof of guilt. The men are presumed innocent and are entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove their guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.

Jose Solorzano-Martinez: Age 31 (d.o.b. 12-4-1988), of the 200 block of North Gifford Street, Elgin, Illinois. Case No. 20CF1773.

Julio Archundia-Sanchez: Age 25 (d.o.b. 2-7-1995), of the 100 block of College Street, Elgin, Illinois. Case No. 20CF1772.
