CHICAGO MAN CHARGED WITH FIRST-DEGREE MURDER IN CARPENTERSVILLE FATAL SHOOTING

August 2, 2021

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 29-year-old **Jamar L. Robinson** with the offenses of first-degree murder and unlawful use of a weapon, Class X felony, in the July 29 shooting death of 30-year-old Jorge Sanchez.

Kane County prosecutors allege that at about 3:15 a.m. July 29, 2021, Robinson fired multiple shots from a handgun at Sanchez, killing him.

Robinson previously dated a resident of the Foxview Apartment Complex, in the 1-99 block of Oxford Road, Carpentersville. Sanchez was staying in an apartment adjacent to the former girlfriend's apartment. His body was found in a hallway at the complex.

Robinson appeared Aug. 1, 2021, in Kane County bond court. Kane County Judge Todd Tarter set Robinson's bail at \$3 million, with 10 percent (\$300,000) to apply for bond. Robinson's next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Aug. 4, 2021, in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Robinson are not proof of guilt. Robinson is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.

The Carpentersville Police Department conducted the investigation.
