### **CARPENTERSVILLE MAN GUILTY OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE**

August 19, 2021

Kane County Judge John A. Barsanti found 41-year-old **Jose Rodriguez-Delgado** guilty of the offense of aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony.

Rodriguez-Delgado waived his right to a jury trial

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Lori Schmidt and Margaret O'Brien presented evidence that between January 2015 and December 2019, Rodriguez-Delgado sexually abused the victim. Rodriguez-Delgado knew the victim, who was younger than 15 years old.

Judge Barsanti set Rodriguez-Delgado's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. Oct. 8, 2021, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing.

In addition to the prison term, Rodriguez-Delgado must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Rodriguez-Delgado remains free on \$5,000 bond.

**ASA Schmidt said:**

"Most disclosures of sexual abuse happen several years, at least, after the abuse. As was the case here, the disclosure doesn't have to be immediate for the defendant to be found guilty. My thanks to a number of people within the community who provided assistance to this victim, particularly the Community Crisis Center of Elgin. In addition, I want to thank investigator Tim Bosshart and advocate Silvia Cruz from the Kane County Child Advocacy Center for their work."
