CARPENTERSVILLE MAN GETS 9 YEARS IN PRISON FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT OF CHILD

February 25, 2021

37-year-old **Nelson V. Ramos** on Feb. 23, 2021, agreed to a sentence of 9 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Tyler Cox stated in court that between August 2017 and October 2017 Ramos sexually assaulted a child he knew. The child was younger than 13 years old.

In addition to the prison term, Ramos must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

In accordance with Illinois law, Ramos must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. He receives credit for 1,217 days served in the Kane County jail.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser said:

"I want to commend this young victim for the courage she showed in disclosing this abuse to her mother, who immediately contacted the police. Too many survivors of sexual abuse are denied justice because those who can help them choose not to believe them when they share their story of abuse. I'm grateful that wasn't the case here. My thanks to the Carpentersville Police Department for referring this case to the Kane County Child Advocacy Center, and to CAC Investigator Tim Bosshart and ASA Cox for their excellent work."
