### **HUNTLEY MAN FACES ATTEMPTED MURDER, HOME INVASION CHARGES IN DECEMBER 28 CARPENTERSVILLE STABBING**

January 2, 2021

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 39-year-old **Joshua A. Doss** with the offenses of:

- Attempt first-degree murder, Class X felony
- Armed violence, Class X felony
- Home invasion, Class X felony
- Aggravated battery, Class 3 felony, 2 counts
- Violating an order of protection, Class A misdemeanor

Kane County prosecutors allege that the afternoon of Dec. 28, 2020, Doss without permission entered a home in the 3100 block of Merrywell Court, Carpentersville, and stabbed the victim twice with a 4-inch knife. Doss knew the victim.

Doss appeared today in Kane County bond court. His bail is set at \$500,000, with 10 percent (\$50,000) to apply for bond.

His next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Jan. 19, 2021, in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Doss are not proof of guilt. Doss is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
