ELGIN MAN FACES GUN CHARGES IN APRIL 29 INCIDENT

May 4, 2021

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 30-year-old **Drew A. Scruggs** with the offenses of:

- Aggravated unlawful use of a weapon, Class 2 felony, 2 counts
- Unlawful use of a weapon by a felon, Class 3 felony
- Reckless discharge of a firearm, Class 4 felony

Kane County prosecutors allege that at about 8:30 p.m. April 29, 2021, Scruggs fired multiple shots from an automatic rifle-style pistol in the 1-99 block of Longwood Place. No one was injured.

Scruggs at the time was free on \$1,500 bond from a March DUI charge. In addition, a Kane County grand jury on April 30, 2021, indicted Scruggs on gun charges related to the alleged March DUI.

Scruggs appeared May 1, 2021, in Kane County bond court. Kane County Judge Alice Tracy set Scruggs' bail at \$250,000, with 10 percent (\$25,000) to apply for bond. Scruggs' next court appearance is set for 9a May 7, 2021, in Courtroom 313 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

Scruggs remains in custody at the Kane County jail.

The charges against Scruggs are not proof of guilt. Scruggs is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
