AURORA MAN SENTENCED TO 15 YEARS FOR SEXUALLY ASSAULTING CHILD

Kane County Judge Alice C. Tracy has sentenced 53-year-old **Jose C. Baron** to 15 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Judge Tracy on Jan. 27, 2021, found Baron guilty of the offenses of criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony; and aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony. Baron waived his right to a jury trial.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Tyler Cox, Samantha Cain and Chris McCall stated during the trial that between 2015 and 2018 Baron sexually assaulted the child victim, whom he knew.

In addition to the prison term, Baron must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

The sentence is 12 years for the sexual assault and 3 years for the sexual abuse. According to Illinois law, Baron must serve at least 85 percent of the 12-year term and he is eligible for day-for-day sentencing on the 3-year term.

Baron receives credit for 175 days served in the Kane County jail.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser said:

"I'm proud of this survivor for having the courage to disclose the sexual abuse committed by a family member over many years, and for having the strength and will to face him and testify against him in court. My thanks to the Kane County Child Advocacy Center staff for their work in the investigation and prosecution of this case."
