### **AURORA MAN GETS 18-YEAR SENTENCE FOR CHILD SEX ASSAULTS**

May 21, 2021

44-year-old **Oscar O. Rojas** on May 20, 2021, agreed to a sentence of 18 years' imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony, 2 counts.

Kane County Judge Alice C. Tracy accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Lori Schmidt stated in court that multiple times between 2007 and 2019 Rojas sexually assaulted the victim. Rojas knew the victim, who was younger than 13 years old when the assaults started.

In addition to the prison term, Rojas must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

In accordance with Illinois law, Rojas must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence. Name receives credit for 707 days served in the Kane County jail, where he has been held since his arrest in lieu of \$175,000 bail.

The Kane County Child Advocacy Center investigated and prosecuted the case.

**ASA Schmidt, the CAC's executive director, said:**

"This victim/survivor showed tremendous courage coming forward and disclosing years of abuse. She told an adult who made a police report. Child predators are stopped when responsible adults listen, hear the disclosures and take action. We hope other victims of sexual abuse know that if they come forward and tell their story, we will listen and we will act."
