MILWAUKEE MAN FACES ATTEMPT MURDER CHARGE AFTER EARLY JAN. 1 SHOOTING AT AURORA PARTY

January 4, 2022

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 23-year-old **Cameron J. Sebastion** with the offenses of:

- Attempt first-degree murder, Class X felony
- Aggravated battery with a firearm, Class X felony
- Aggravated discharge of a firearm, Class X felony, 3 counts

Kane County prosecutors allege that early Jan. 1, 2022, Sebastion, who was attending a party in the 800 block of Huntington Drive, Aurora, fired multiple shots from a handgun at three victims, striking one victim in the arm.

Sebastion appeared Jan. 4, 2022, in Kane County bond court. Kane County Judge Julia Yetter set Sebastion's bail at \$1 million, with 10 percent (\$100,000) to apply for bond. Judge Yetter set Sebastion's next court appearance for 9 a.m. Jan. 19, 2022, in Courtroom 211 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Sebastion are not proof of guilt. Sebastion is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
