AURORA MAN CHARGED IN JANUARY 2021 SHOOTING DEATH

BAIL SET AT \$1 MILLION; NEXT COURT DATE IS JAN. 14

January 10, 2022

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie Mosser has charged 23-year-old **Daniel Aguirre** with the offense of first-degree murder, 2 counts, for the Jan. 15, 2021, shooting death of 32-year-old Fernando Carapia of Aurora.

Kane County prosecutors allege that the afternoon of Jan. 15, 2021, Aguirre was a passenger in a vehicle that traveled to the 300 block of South Spencer Street, Aurora. Aguirre exited the car and fired multiple gunshots, killing Carapia.

Aguirre is in custody at the Kane County jail. His bail is set at \$1 million, with 10 percent (\$100,000) to apply for bond. His next court appearance is set for 9 a.m. Jan. 14, 2022, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The Aurora Police Department conducted the investigation, which continues. Anyone with information should call Aurora police at (630) 256-5500.

The charges against Aguirre are not proof of guilt. Aguirre is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
