19-YEAR-OLD GABRIEL GARCIA CHARGED WITH MURDER IN DEATH OF HIS BROTHER, DAVID GARCIA

BAIL SET AT \$3 MILLION; IN CUSTODY AT KANE COUNTY JAIL

RE: Gabriel Garcia: Age 19 (d.o.b. 1-17-2003), of the 29W block of County Ridge Road, Warrenville, Illinois. Case No. 2022CF1329.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and Aurora Chief of Police Keith Cross announce that 19-year-old **Gabriel Garcia** is charged with the offense of first-degree murder, 2 counts, in the death of his brother, 21-year-old David Garcia of Aurora.

SA Mosser alleges that, during the early morning of July 25, 2022, the Garcia brothers were arguing when Gabriel Garcia pointed a handgun at David Garcia and fired a single shot, striking him. The office of Kane County Coroner Rob Russell determined the cause of death to be a single gunshot wound to the chest.

Bail was set at \$3 million, with 10 percent (\$300,000) to apply for bond and a warrant was issued for the arrest of Mr. Garcia. The U.S. Marshal Service's Great Lakes Fugitive Task Force took Garcia into custody July 26, 2022. Garcia appeared July 28, 2022, in Kane County bond court.

Judge Alice C. Tracy today set Garcia's next court appearance for 9 a.m. on August 12, 2022, in Courtroom 313 at the Kane County Judicial Center. He remains in custody at the Kane County jail.

The charges against Gabriel Garcia are not proof of guilt. Garcia is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
