TWO MEN FACE ATTEMPT MURDER, GUN CHARGES AFTER THURSDAY SHOOTING IN ELGIN

March 5, 2022

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announced today that she has charged 25-year-old **Damarques Enochs** and 29-year-old **Taviris Paul** each with the offenses of:

- Attempt first-degree murder, Class X felony
- Aggravated battery with a firearm, Class X felony
- Armed robbery with a firearm, Class X felony

SA Mosser alleges that in the late morning of March 3, 2022, the victim saw Enochs and Paul stealing his property from his home in the 1200 block of Fleetwood Drive, Elgin. When the victim confronted the men, they shot him in the chest and fled.

Enochs and Paul appeared today in Kane County bond court. Bail for each was set at \$750,000 with 10 percent (\$75,000) to apply for bond. The next court appearance for each man is set for 9 a.m. March 9, 2022, in Courtroom 305 at the Kane County Judicial Center. Both men remain in custody at the Kane County jail.

This case remains under investigation. Anyone with information should call the Elgin Police Department's Major Investigations Division at (847) 289-2600.

The charges against Enochs and Paul are not proof of guilt. Enochs and Paul are presumed innocent and are entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove their guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
