ST. CHARLES MAN GUILTY OF 2019 SEXUAL ASSAULT

November 16, 2022

RE: Jason A. Carter: Age 45 (d.o.b. 6-13-1977), of the 300 block of Illinois Street, St. Charles, Illinois. Case No. 2019CF1167.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that a jury has found 45-year-old **Jason A. Carter** guilty of the offenses of:

- Home invasion, Class X felony, 2 counts
- Criminal sexual assault, Class 1 felony

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Amanda Busljeta and Matt Rodgers presented the following evidence:

At about 2 a.m. on June 16, 2019, Carter heard the victim and her boyfriend return home to the neighboring residence. A short time later after the boyfriend briefly left the residence, Carter entered their residence, saw the victim asleep on the sofa and sexually assaulted her. When interviewed by police, Carter admitted to the criminal act.

Judge Alice C. Tracy set Carter's next court appearance for 1:30 p.m. on January 13, 2023, in Courtroom 313 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing.

Carter faces a minimum sentence of six years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections. In addition to the prison term, Carter must register for life as a sexual offender according to the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Judge Tracy revoked bond upon conviction and ordered Carter taken into custody at the Kane County jail. Carter had been free on \$10,000 bond.

ASA Busljeta said: "I'm grateful the jurors saw through Mr. Carter's ridiculous explanation of the events that occurred that night. My thanks to the victim for her bravery and her belief in our efforts to deliver justice. Thanks also to ASA Rodgers for his assistance, to victim advocate Martha Martinez and to the St. Charles Police Department for the excellent work in investigating this case."
