DRU JARVIS INDICTED ON MURDER CHARGES IN 2020 APPARENT ROAD RAGE SHOOTING IN ELGIN

41-YEAR-OLD FRANCISCO TRUJILLO-USCANGA SHOT AND KILLED

RE: **Dru K. Jarvis**: Age 23 (d.o.b. 11-17-1998), last address of the 1300 block of Cunat Court, Lake in the Hills, Illinois. Case No. 2022CF1325.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and Elgin Chief of Police Ana Lalley announce that a grand jury has indicted 23-year-old **Dru K. Jarvis** for the offenses of:

- First-degree murder, 2 counts
- Attempt first-degree murder, Class X felony
- Armed violence, Class X felony
- Unlawful possession of a weapon by a street gang member, Class 2 felony

SA Mosser alleges that early the morning of Aug. 22, 2020, Jarvis was a passenger in a white sedan that was traveling south on Route 31 (North State Street) in Elgin. 41-year-old Francisco Trujillo-Uscanga of Elgin was the front-seat passenger in a light blue Mini Cooper that also was traveling south on Route 31. The second victim was driving the Mini Cooper. Near the intersection with Kimball Street, the sedan pulled alongside the Mini Cooper and Jarvis fired multiple gunshots at it. Trujillo-Uscanga was struck by gunfire in the torso and died a short time later at AMITA Health St. Joseph Hospital. The driver was struck with multiple gunshots.

The victims were on their way home from a Huntley restaurant where they worked as cooks.

Jarvis' bail is set at \$750,000. His next appearance is scheduled for 9 a.m. Dec. 7, 2022, in Courtroom 319 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Jarvis are not proof of guilt. Jarvis is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
