ROBERT McBRIDE OF AURORA FACES MURDER CHARGES IN MARCH 2015 SHOOTING DEATH OF BRYCE STIFF

April 6, 2023

*RE: **Robert T. McBride**: Age 43 (d.o.b. 8-20-1979), of the 2200 block of Mulberry Court, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2023CF347.*

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and Aurora Chief of Police Keith Cross announce that a grand jury has indicted **Robert T. McBride** for the offenses of:

- First-degree murder (six counts)
- Second-degree murder, Class 1 felony (two counts)

State's Attorney Mosser alleges the following facts:

On March 7, 2015 McBride fired a gun, causing the death of 33-year-old Bryce Stiff of Montgomery, Illinois.

A judge issued a warrant for McBride's arrest and set his bail at \$2 million with 10 percent (\$200,000) to apply for bond.

McBride's next court appearance is set for May 31, 2023 at 9 a.m. in Courtroom 211 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against McBride are not proof of guilt. McBride is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
