AURORA MAN GETS 15 YEARS FOR CHILD SEX ASSAULT

*RE: **Jose A. Jimenez**: Age 38 (d.o.b. 5-25-1985), of Margarets Lane, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2022CF744.*

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that **Jose A. Jimenez** has agreed to a sentence of 15 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony.

Judge Alice C. Tracy accepted the plea.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Stacey Wittman stated the following facts in court:

Between January and March 2022, Jimenez sexually assaulted the child. Jimenez knew the child, who was younger than 12 years old.

In addition to the prison term, Jimenez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Jimenez must serve at least 85% of the sentence. Jimenez receives credit for 394 days served in the Kane County jail.

ASA Wittman said: "This victim disclosed the abuse to a school social worker, who swiftly contacted authorities. My thanks to the social worker and the victim's family members who supported her throughout this ordeal. I'm grateful to the victim for her courage throughout this prosecution and for trusting us to ensure she gets justice. Thanks also to the team at the Child Advocacy Center for their work and support, including investigator Sandra Navarette and advocate Leslie Zarate."
