AURORA MAN GUILTY FOR SEXUALLY ABUSING CHILD

May 5, 2023

RE: Alberto Vazquez: Age 36 (d.o.b. 3-28-1987), of the 1100 block of Molitor Road, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2020CF1141.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that a jury has found **Alberto Vazquez** guilty of the offense of aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony (two counts).

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Stacey Wittman and Alexandra Storto presented the following facts in court:

On June 1, 2020, Vazquez sexually abused the victim, whom he knew. The victim was younger than 18 years old.

Judge David P. Kliment set Vazquez's next court appearance for July 13, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 305 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing.

In addition to the sentence, Vazquez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Vazquez remains free on \$7,500 bond. Additionally, Judge Kliment placed him on electronic home monitoring.

ASA Wittman said: "A trusted adult told this victim that she could always come to her. The trust between that person and the victim allowed for a prompt disclosure. I thank that individual for their advocacy on behalf of this child. I'm grateful for this victim's patience and perseverance. It was nearly three years from the time she was abused until her abuser was found guilty, yet she remained determined to face him in court. Thanks also to ASA Storto, Child Advocacy Center advocates Leslie Zarate and JoAnne Johnsen, and to retired CAC Investigator Chris Tunney, who returned to testify at this trial."
