AURORA MAN GETS 12-YEAR PRISON SENTENCE FOR DISSEMINATING CHILD PORNOGRAPHY

RE: Gabriel M. Martinez: Age 30 (d.o.b. 12-20-1992), of the 900 block of Pearl Street, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2022CF1919.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that **Gabriel M. Martinez** has agreed to a sentence of 12 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to the offense of child pornography, Class X felony.

Judge Julia Yetter accepted the plea.

Assistant State's Attorney Matthew Rodgers stated the following facts in court: Prior to September 8, 2022, Martinez disseminated via social media a video containing a child younger than 13 engaged in a sexual act.

In addition to the prison term, Martinez must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Martinez is eligible for day-for-day sentencing. He receives credit for 373 days served in the Kane County jail.

ASA Rodgers said: "The child depicted in this video is victimized every time someone views it. Child pornography is not a victimless crime. My thanks to Det. Robert Jones of the Aurora Police Department for his work on this investigation."
