## CARPENTERSVILLE MIDDLE SCHOOL TEACHER CHARGED WITH SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD, GROOMING AND BURGLARY

March 7, 2024

RE: **Kevin D. Lee**: Age 24 (d.o.b. 07-30-1999), of the 500 block of Waterford Lane, South Elgin, Illinois. Case No. 2024CF466.

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and St. Charles Chief of Police James Keegan announce that **Kevin D. Lee** is charged with the offenses of:

- Burglary, class 1 felony
- Sexual Exploitation of a Child, class 4 felony
- Grooming, class 4 felony

State's Attorney Mosser alleges that on February 26, 2024 Lee was present without authority at the Norris Recreation Center in St. Charles, Illinois where he approached a child in a locker room and made an inappropriate comment to the child. As of February 26, 2024, Lee was employed as a teacher and wrestling coach at Carpentersville Middle School.

According to Illinois law, Lee is being detained in the Kane County jail while his case is pending.

Lee's next court appearance is scheduled for March 20, 2024 at 9 a.m. in Courtroom 211 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Lee are not proof of guilt. Lee is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
