**CHICAGO MAN CHARGED WITH AGGRAVATED
CRIMINAL SEXUAL ASSAULT AT MARKLUND HOME IN
GENEVA**

RE: Isaiah Fields: Age 22 (d.o.b. 07-06-2001), of the 5000 block of W. Maple Ave, Chicago, Illinois. Case No. 2024CF000974.

St. Charles, Ill. - Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and Kane County Sheriff Ron Hain announce that **Isaiah Fields** is charged with the offenses of:

- Aggravated Criminal Sexual Assault, Class X Felony, (3 counts)
- Criminal Sexual Assault, Class 1 Felony
- Aggravated Battery, Class 3 Felony

State's Attorney Jamie Mosser alleges the following facts:

On or about August 1, 2023 through September 5, 2023, Isaiah Fields sexually assaulted the victim, who he knew had a severe or profound intellectual disability and was unable to give consent.

The victim was a resident of Marklund Home in Geneva. It was discovered in April of 2024 that the victim was nearly fully pregnant, and the victim later gave birth.

The Kane County Sheriff's Office conducted an investigation that involved securing multiple buccal swab DNA tests from current and previous male employees. After Field's DNA test came back positive, the Sheriff secured a sealed order for his arrest.

Fields was arrested and brought to the Kane County jail on Friday, May 10, where he remains while his case is pending.

SA Mosser said: “The defendant is facing serious charges for his heinous actions against a vulnerable individual. I want to thank the Sheriff’s office for their thorough investigation. Our office is committed to seeking justice for the victim and holding perpetrators of such egregious crimes fully accountable. We will vigorously prosecute this case to ensure that justice is served and to protect our community from such reprehensible acts.”

The charges against Fields are not proof of guilt. Fields is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state’s burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
