**ROCKFORD MAN SENTENCED TO 21 YEARS FOR CHILD
SEXUAL ABUSE OFFENSES**

*RE: **Jose F. Reyna**: Age 64 (d.o.b. 03/02/1960), of the 4400 block of Calico Circle, Rockford, Illinois. Case No. 2022CF1928*

St. Charles, Ill. - Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that **Jose F. Reyna** has agreed to a sentence of 18 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to three counts of the offense of Predatory Criminal Sexual Assault of a Child, Class X felony, and 3 years of imprisonment in exchange for a guilty plea on one count of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse, Class 2 felony. Each term must be served consecutively.

Judge Barsanti accepted the plea on May 15, 2024.

Assistant State's Attorney Stacey Wittman stated the following facts in court:

Between January 1, 2022 and October 1, 2022, Reyna sexually assaulted a child on more than one occasion. The defendant sexually abused another child between January 1, 2017 and October 1, 2022. Both children were younger than 13 years old and were known by Reyna.

In addition to the prison term, Reyna must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

In accordance with Illinois law, Reyna must serve at least 85 percent of the sentence on the Predatory Criminal Sexual Assault charges. Reyna must serve at least 50 percent of the sentence on the Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse charge. Reyna receives credit for 533 days served in the Kane County jail and the Cook County jail.

ASA Wittman said: “Thanks in part to another survivor coming forward with allegations of the sexual abuse she had endured, these two victims were also able to disclose the abuse they suffered at the hands of this defendant. I am grateful for the family’s patience while this case has been pending. My thanks to the team at Kane County Child Advocacy Center, including investigator David Smith and victim advocate Julie Pohlman for their excellent work on this case.”
