AURORA MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO SEXUAL ABUSE OF MINOR

April 27, 2015

An Aurora man is headed to prison for engaging in sexual acts with a minor child he knew.

Travis A. Armstrong, 31 (d.o.b. 1-26-1984), most recently of the 400 block of North River Street, Aurora, on Friday, April 24, 2015, agreed to a sentence of four years in the Illinois Department of Corrections in exchange for a guilty plea to aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony.

Associate Judge Clint Hull accepted the plea.

Prosecutors presented evidence that between Jan. 1, 2014, and Jan. 25, 2014, Armstrong engaged in sexual acts with the victim, who was younger than 17 year old at the time. Armstrong knew the victim.

In addition to the prison term, Armstrong must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

According to Illinois law, Armstrong is eligible for day-for-day credit. He receives credit for at least 371 days served in the Kane County jail, where he has been held since his arrest in lieu of \$100,000 bail. Bond was revoked upon conviction.

The case was prosecuted by Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Andrew Whitfield.
