### **AURORA MAN FOUND GUILTY OF CHILD SEX ASSAULTS**

July 10, 2023

*RE: **Lewis T. Richardson**: Age 63 (d.o.b. 5-15-1960), of the 1600 block of Park Vista Lane, Aurora, Illinois. Case No. 2018CF2065.*

Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser announces that Judge Elizabeth Flood has found **Lewis T. Richardson** guilty of the offenses of:

- Predatory criminal sexual assault of a child, Class X felony (2 counts)
- Aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2 felony (2 counts)

Richardson waived his right to a jury trial.

Kane County Assistant State's Attorneys Matthew Rodgers and Margaret O'Brien presented the following evidence in court:

Between June 2005 and June 2017, Richardson had sexual contact with the victim. Richardson knew the victim, who was younger than 13 years old.

Judge Flood set Richardson's next court appearance for September 1, 2023, at 1:30 p.m., in Courtroom 311 at the Kane County Judicial Center for motions and sentencing. Richardson faces a minimum sentence of 12 years of imprisonment in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

In addition to the prison term, Richardson must register for life as a sexual offender in accordance with the Illinois Sexual Offender Registration Act.

Judge Flood revoked bond upon conviction and ordered Richardson taken into custody at the Kane County jail.
