State's Attorney's Office to Review Officer-Involved Death in Aurora

St. Charles, Ill. - On the morning of March 19, 2025, an officer-involved shooting that resulted in the death of a suspect occurred in Aurora in the area of S. Broadway St. and Hazel Ave. The suspect's identity has not yet been released by the Kane County Coroner's Office, who will be performing an autopsy today.

The Kane County Major Crimes Task Force is leading the investigation of the officer-involved shooting. They will provide a complete report to Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser who will determine if the use of force was justified. It is a thorough, fair, and just process that will take place over the next few months.

The Major Crimes Task Force comprises law enforcement officers from throughout Kane County. They provide timely and independent assistance to member agencies that become involved in a major investigation, such as an officer-involved shooting. No officers from the Aurora Police Department will be involved in this investigation.
