## **Judge Detains Doctor Charged with Sexual Assault and Exploitation of 16-Year-Old Minor**

*RE: Trevor J. Roston: Age 33 (d.o.b. 5-28-1992), of the 2100 block of W. Lawrence Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. Case No. 2025CF2890.*

**ST. CHARLES, IL** – Kane County State's Attorney Jamie L. Mosser and Elgin Chief of Police Ana Lally announce that **Trevor J. Roston** is charged with the offenses of:

- Aggravated criminal sexual assault, class X felony
- Criminal sexual assault, class 1 felony
- Unlawful restraint, class 4 felony
- Aggravated criminal sexual abuse, class 2 felony (4 counts)
- Sexual exploitation of a child, class A misdemeanor (2 counts)

State's Attorney Mosser alleges that on or about November 29, 2025, Trevor Roston unlawfully restrained and sexually assaulted a 16-year-old minor with an intellectual disability. Roston is charged with having followed the minor into a single-use poolside bathroom of an Elgin hotel that they were both staying at, locked the door behind him, and sexually assault the minor.

Roston is a medical doctor who at the time of the alleged assault was employed at Advocate Sherman Hospital in Elgin as an adult hospitalist. Although Roston is board certified in pediatrics, he did not practice pediatrics in his role in Elgin, According to Advocate Health. Roston's employment has since been terminated. Investigators do not believe that the victim was a previous patient of Roston or that Roston knew the victim prior to the alleged assault. Roston was staying at the hotel in his personal time.

On December 15, Roston was brought to court for a pretrial detention hearing, during which the State argued for his detention. Granting the State's petition, the court ordered Roston detained in the Kane County jail while his case is pending. Roston's next court date is set for December 29, 2025, at 9 a.m. in Courtroom 211 at the Kane County Judicial Center.

The charges against Roston are not proof of guilt. Roston is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the state's burden to prove guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
